Anne-Dominique Degryse, DVM, graduated from the Veterinary School of Ghent, Belgium in 1980.

She is a Diplomate of the European College of Laboratory Animal Medicine (Dipl. ECLAM) and a Honorary Diplomate of the American College of Laboratory Animal Medicine (DACLAM (Hon)).

She has co-authored more than 100 publications/posters relative to laboratory science and medicine in specialized international journals.

In 1997 she co-founded of the European Society of Laboratory Animal Veterinarians (ESLAV), of which she is Past- President. She is also Past-President of the European College of Laboratory Animal Medicine (ECLAM) and was in that position member of, or heading several Council Working Groups.

Since 2010, and still currently, she is Member of the FELASA-ECLAM-ESLAV Working Group on Severity Classification of Procedures. She is co-organiser of Itl. Workshops on Severity Classification, as promoted by the European Commission. So far more than 60 have been held in various European countries.
